The Sunny Art Award is an international art prize hosted by Sunny Art Centre, London. This fine art competition is a global platform giving an opportunity to any emerging and established artist to showcase their talents. Their works will represent the diversity of art and culture, from two-dimensional works such as paintings, drawings and photography to three-dimensional sculptures, ceramics and jewellery. **A total cash fund of £6,000 is awarded to the prize winners.**

The Sunny Art Award represents the international art scenes of London, Beijing, Guangzhou and Macau. It will promote an exchange between the creativity of Eastern and Western cultures.

**First Prize** will receive £3,000, a public solo exhibition at Sunny Art Centre in London, a one-month residency and a show at our partners' galleries.

**Second Prize** will receive £2,000, a group exhibition, a one-month residency and a show at our partners' galleries.

**Third Prize** will receive £1,000, a group exhibition, a one-month residency and a show at our partners' galleries.

**30 Shortlisted Artists'** works will be exhibited during the summer at Sunny Art Centre, London. Out of these 30 shortlisted artists there will be an opportunity for 10 of these artists to exhibit their works at our partners' galleries.

The group exhibitions will be held at the Sunny Art Centre in London, as well as our partners' galleries. This includes the Haidian District Art Centre in Beijing, the AIP Art Centre in Guangzhou or the Blanc Art Gallery in Macau. The one-month artist residency programme is the creation of the collaboration with our partners' galleries.

Moreover, artists should provide Sunny Art Centre with the retail price which shall include VAT charges. **If your work is not for sale, it cannot be entered into this competition.** If your work has been shortlisted or selected for the exhibition, it will be offered for sale for a period of time till the end of the exhibition(s) through various channels with our art dealing team. All work submitted shall be available for sale until the end of the competition and exhibition(s). The collection of the artwork will be organised by the artist and Sunny Art Centre will take a commission of 30% from the sale price. Sunny Art Centre will take payment from the buyer of the artwork and, once payment is received, will pay the Artist 70% of the sale price.

## Frequently asked questions

Why participate?

1. **Opportunity to exhibit at a prestigious gallery in the heart of London, as well as our partners' galleries.** This includes the Haidian District Art Centre in Beijing, the AIP Art Centre in Guangzhou or the Blanc Art Gallery in Macau.
2. Have your artwork exposed to thousands of visitors, professional academics, art collectors and art enthusiasts, including local and international VIP guests.
3. Unique gateway through artist residency to expose your artworks in the most prestigious art galleries and top museums in China, such as 798 Art District, Haidian District Beijing Center, Guangzhou AIP Centre.
4. Chance to sell your work to international buyers and collectors.
5. **Showcase your work through The Sunny Art Centre's website and marketing material.**
6. Opportunity to win prizes and awards.
7. Have your profile raised through the media coverage the art centre generates.
8. If selected, you and a guest will be invited to attend the exclusive Private View in London.
9. All selected artworks are promoted in the Sunny Art Award 2017 exhibition catalogues.
10. Having work accepted adds provenance to your artwork, as they will be catalogued and added to archives for generations to come.

Who can submit?

1. The competition is open to all artists from around the world.
2. Artists must be aged 18 years or over as of 10<sup>th</sup> April 2017.
3. Sculpture, Paintings, drawings, original prints, photography, ceramics and jewellery artworks are accepted.
4. The artworks, if shortlisted for judging, must be the same work previously submitted as a digital image and be available for the next stage of judging and if selected for the exhibition(s) including the whole exhibition period. We will not be able to allow collection within the exhibition period.
5. Maximum size is 275 cm x 275 cm, including frame.
6. The competition is limited to four entries per artist. All entries must be of original works that have been completed within three years prior to 10<sup>th</sup> June 2017.
7. On receipt of the registration and entry fee, a confirmation email will be sent to the artist.
8. All correspondence with artists will be via email unless specifically requested otherwise.

Accepted media

2 - D Media, which includes Painting, Drawing, Illustration, Photography, Printmaking etc. (Maximum size is 275 m x 275 cm, including frame)

3 - D Media, which includes Sculpture, Ceramic, Jewellery, Mixed Media. (Maximum size is 275cm x 275 cm)

How to enter?

To register your entry for the *Sunny Art Award 2017* please click the [Online Submission](#) to start your application. It is now a requirement that each artist should upload an image of the work when registering for the competition online. It is compulsory that the artist uploads one image of the entire work (including all the parts of a diptych or triptych). Please note that the first round of judging is completed digitally. It is therefore important that the photographs uploaded by the artist are of a high quality.

Entry forms and fees must be received by Sunny Art Centre by 23.59pm on 20 June 2017. The entry fee for this competition is £25 for one artwork, £32 for two artworks, £40 for three artworks and £45 for four artworks.

### Final Judging

The same panel of judges will choose the prize-winning artwork from those works selected for exhibition. Works shortlisted for the next stage of judging must be sent by the dates given on the website. This information will be given to you in full in an email advising that your work has been shortlisted and the announcement will also be made in our website; artworks submitted late will not be judged. An email will be sent confirming whether a work has been accepted or not and in which time collection dates will be available for those works that will not be selected.

### Sale

All work submitted must be available for sale. The Artist's Prices on the Entry Form are the final prices paid to the Artist and they should be carefully considered, as this will help to effectively promote the artists and their careers. Work that is not for sale cannot be entered into this competition. If your work has been shortlisted or selected for the exhibition, it will be offered for sale for a period of time till the end of the exhibition(s) through various channels with our art dealing team (including online and offline). The Artist accepts that all work submitted will be available for sale in the exhibition(s) and on our website until the end of the competition and exhibition(s) when the artwork is collected by The Artist, and that the Sunny Art Centre will take a commission of 30% plus VAT from the sale price. The Sunny Art Centre will take payment from the buyer of the artwork and, once payment is received, will pay The Artist **the Artist's Price stated on the Entry Form.**

### Delivery & Insurance

If you are unable to deliver your work in person we recommend using a professional Art Courier. Delivery is at the artist's own expense. By applying to The Sunny Art Prize exhibition, you agree that your work/s may be transported to and exhibited in London, United Kingdom. By submitting the entry form, The Artist accepts that, if successful during stage 1, will submit the original artwork/s for the second stage of competition and exhibitions. The Sunny Art Centre will not be liable for any loss or damage to any artworks physically submitted at any point in the prize, caused either in transit to and from the exhibition, or during any period of storage, packing or unpacking, exhibition or in any period in which the work is in their keeping. We recommend that The Artist takes out insurance to cover the artwork, especially in transit and while at the Sunny Art Centre or sponsors' premises.

All artists are responsible for delivering their artwork to Sunny Art Centre; artists must also arrange collection of art works from Sunny Art Centre after the exhibition period. Alternatively, Sunny Art Centre can arrange the return of artworks to the artist for an agreed upon packaging and delivery fee. If at any time during the exhibition period the artwork requires shipping to another location, Sunny Art Centre will cover all costs.

### Intellectual Property Rights

The artist must be the owner of the artwork/s and that the pieces submitted are of his/her own origination. The artist must hold all moral and intellectual property rights. The Sunny Art Centre has the right to copy and/or reproduce the artworks to communicate and/or issue such copies to the public (at no cost). This is in connection with the exhibition, for advertising the sale of the Works, for educational and public workshops, for general marketing or promotional purposes and other related activities. They include, without limitation, the incorporation of images of the artworks within promotional and marketing materials, postcards, catalogues, posters, DVDs, on **Sunny Art Centre's websites, in workshop presentations and on information screens throughout the exhibiting gallery and any media now known or hereafter devised.**

- Exhibition selection announced online: 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2017
- Art Prize winner to be announced at the Exhibition Opening Night at Sunny Art Centre: 25<sup>th</sup> July 2017
- Shortlisted Artwork Exhibition in the Sunny Art Centre (London, UK): 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017 – 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017
- Private Viewing. All exhibiting artists are invited: 25<sup>th</sup> July 2017
- Solo exhibition of the Art Prize winner: 1<sup>st</sup> September – 7<sup>th</sup> September 2017
- Artist Residency: start date negotiated with winners. Three winners are expected to select the same city from Beijing or Guangzhou in China for a month
